TAX HELP

Volunteer tax help will again be offered at the Saratoga Springs Library through VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) for families with incomes under \$49,000.

-On **Saturday and Sundays** (12-3pm), help will be available on a **drop-in basis**, starting **2/06/10**. (1st 25 people per day, numbers will start to be given out when library opens – 9am Sat, 12N Sun)
