### Attend Our Monthly Virtual Teen Advisory Group (TAG) Meetings

### Teen Display/Program Idea

Do you have ideas for book displays we can do in the teen area? Can you think of a fun program or event that other teens might enjoy? Write up a description of your idea and include the supplies needed. (15-30 Minutes of Service)

### Book Recommendation

Write 1 complete sentence for each of the following questions: Why did you like this book? What kind of reader would enjoy it? Why? Include the title, author, your first name, and grade. (30 Minutes of Service)

### Book Trailer

Create a short (1-3 min.) video advertising a book you read and enjoyed. Use Canva or Animoto to create your video and use royalty free images from Unsplash or Pixabay. Check out this example: <https://tinyurl.com/jw46tpts>. (1-2 Service Hours)

### Booklist

Compile a list of 10-15 books for teens on a chosen theme. Try to include books that you have read and liked. You can also ask your friends what books they are reading. Make sure the books are in the [SSPL online catalog](#) and hyperlink to those books in a Word document. Include the Title and Author of the book. [Need ideas?](#) (1 Service Hour)

### Trivia Questions

Create a themed trivia game in [Kahoot!](#) with 10 multiple choice questions and 5 True/False questions. Themes can be specific or general (ex: Weird Science Facts, Popular Movies, Harry Potter). Add photos to your game from Unsplash or Pixabay. (1 Service Hour)

### Marketing/Flyers

Advertise a teen program or book by creating a flyer, handout, video or presentation using [Canva](#). Remember to use images from Unsplash or Pixabay. If you like art, you can also create something original using online drawing tools or pen and paper. (1-2 Service Hours)

### Recorded Book Reading

Choose a picture book and record yourself reading in a clear voice, making sure to show the illustrations. Contact your teen librarian for approval of your book selection and for additional guidelines. (1 Service Hour)
